<b>Maths</b>	<p>For this week only:            Can you say your 3, 4, and 8 times tables? Find songs on Youtube to help you remember them and sing them to your family.            Then play games such as bingo to play against your family. Pick 6 numbers on your bingo board. Whichever timestable you are practising, pick 6 numbers that are a multiple of that e.g. if I was learning my 8s I may pick 16, 32, 40, 48, 56, 80. Then choose calculations e.g. <math>2 \times 8</math> and if you have the answer to that on your bingo board, you cross it off. First person to cross all 6 off wins.</p>
<b>Reading</b>	<p>Title: Battle of Largs            See attachment for reading and question sheet</p>
<b>Writing</b>	<p>From your curriculum research on Viking raids; use images (or draw your own) of Vikings during the raids. Draw speech bubbles or thought bubbles from your image and write what the Vikings might have been thinking or saying. Use your research to make it valid.</p>
<b>Wider Curriculum</b>	<p>Where did the Vikings raid/invade?</p>  <p>Use image above and begin to answer questions(predict): What could they be doing? Where are they? What could they want? How could this change life in England? How did they get here? What did they come for?            Research Viking raids using a computer to answer the above questions.</p>
