	picture or short video clip of yourself doing your favourite exercise. Exercising
	daily really does make you feel happier and it's fun too!
Maths	This week learn the colour blue. Can you find things that are light blue and dark
	blue? Recognise and read numbers 0, 1, 10 and 11. Can you write them down or draw
	them with your finger? Find and name a circle and learn that it has 1 curved side.
Writing	This week practise making and writing your first name in as many different ways as
	you can. You might want to focus on the first letter of your name. If you can do
	this already write your surname. Try saying the letters in your name aloud.
	Try writing your name for a purpose. You could make a sign for your bedroom door
	or make a special card for someone and write your name inside,
Reading	Look on YouTube Read Write Inc. set 1 sounds. Watch the video of the little
	girl saying all of the sounds correctly. Try to join in daily so you don't forget them!
	This week's sounds are m a s d t i
	Use the letters to make, spell aloud, write and read the words a, at, sat, and mat.
	Ask an adult to sound out the letters below.
	j-u-m-p, r-u-n, h-o-p, j-o-g, f-r-ee-ze.
	After listening to the sounds blend them together and do the action for each word.
	Did you guess them all?
