P.E. Try exercising both your body and fingers and join in with dough disco this week. You will find a session on Spread the Happiness TV on YouTube led by Shonette Bason-Wood. Use those strong fingers to button or zip up your coat. Maths This week learn the colours red and pink. Can you find anything red or pink in your house or garden? Find out your families favourite colours. Recognise and read numbers 2, 3, 12 and 13. Can you count aloud to 5/10 and count 5/10 of your toys? Make numbers 2, 3, 12 and 13 with playdough or write them down. You could even draw them in flour with your finger? Find a square and count its sides and corners. Can you recite your birthday too? Writing Ask an adult to write the names of everyone in your family on individual pieces of paper. Can you find your name amongst them? Spell out the letters in your name. Repeat this lots of times until you remember it. Ask an adult to write the letters in your name on squares. Can you put them in the correct sequence? You could focus on the first letter of your name or try to sequence your surname. Try writing your name in chalk, felt tip, paint or water. Reading Watch the clip of the little girl saying the letters from Read Write Inc. set 1 on YouTube. Try to join in daily so you don't forget them! This week's sounds are n p g o c k. Find an object beginning with each one. Use the letters learnt so far to make, spell aloud, write and read the words an, pan, can, man, and tan. Do you know that these words rhyme and all have 'an' in them. Make up a rhyming name. Mine is Mrs Boyes has lots of toys.
