Subject	Nursery Learning Challenges
P.E.	Have a family sports day. Make up some fun activities and get everyone to join in. Send me a picture or short video clip of yourself joining in.
Wider Curriculum	This week learn to sing Row, Row Your Boat and make your own boat that floats. Look at pictures of boats to help you with your design. Make some oars, a sail or a flag. Find suitable materials by putting different objects in water to find an object that floats and is waterproof. Take a picture of it and email it to me. I would love to see what you have made.
Writing	This week make up a name for your boat. Ask an adult to help you write your boat name on a sign, try to include your name. You could try writing the initial sound in your name, your first name, surname or a sentence. For example, I am John Smith.
Reading	Choose your favourite book and ask an adult to read it to you. Talk about why you like it. Practise saying this week's letter sounds u b f e l h Use the letters learnt so far to make, spell aloud, write and read the words a, at, cat, pat, bat, and hat . Can you say a word that rhymes with rat or chat. Ask an adult to sound out the letters below. c-a-t, h-a-t, b-a-t, p-a-t, ch-a-t . After listening to the sounds blend them together and do an action for each word and say the word you can hear.
Maths	This week learn the colour yellow. Find objects in your house or garden that are yellow. Are they all the same shade? Are some dark and others pale yellow? Recognise and read numbers 4, 5, 14 and 15. Can you write them down or draw them with your finger? Find and name a triangle and learn that it has 3 sides.
