P.E.	Try a new exercise this week. I started riding my bike last week and had forgotten how
	much fun it is. It doesn't matter what you choose to do just keep being active!
	Exercising daily really does makes you feel happier and it's fun too!
Maths	Ask everyone in your family what their favourite number is and write the numbers down
	if you can. Which number was the biggest and which one was the smallest? Hide
	numbers 1 to 10 around your house or garden. When you have found them all put them
	in sequence. Write the numbers 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10 twice on paper, leaves or
	stones. Play pairs by picking 2 numbers up at a time. Can you find two the same?
Writing	Draw a picture of 4 things you might find or use at the seaside.
	Try to write the beginning sound of each object you have chosen.
	You could choose: bucket spade ice cream fish.
	You will learn the beginning sounds of words. For example bucket begins with b and
	spade begins with s. You could even play I spy with my little eye again.
Reading	Look on youtube Read Write Inc set 1 sounds. Lovely video of a little girl saying them
	all your child could watch it and join in daily.

	w x y z Keep practising them as you will need to know them in Reception.
	Ask an adult to sound out the letters in these words.
	Sh-e-ll f-i-sh s-a-n-d sh-i-p s-w-i-m
	When you have listened to the sounds, blend them together, and guess the word
	sounded out. If you get them right try some different ones.
Wider	Fill a bucket or a bowl with water. Put some containers in the bowl and fill and empty
Curriculum	them. Find out which container holds the most water and which one holds the least.
	Have fun finding out and don't get too wet! Send me a picture of your experiment.
