| Maths | This week, ask an adult in your house to see if you can look at the coins they have in their purse or pocket. Can you find a 1p, 2p, 5p and 10p? Can you put them in order of value? Can you collect 1p coins? Can you make 3p, 5p, 4p with the 1p coins? Find a 2p coin, how many pennies make 2p? Can you touch a 2p coin and say “1, 2” for 2 pennies? Make sure you give your money back! |
