Subject	Nursery Learning Challenges
P.E.	This week walk, run, cycle, trampoline, dough disco, dance or do Kids Zumba.  Have fun doing whatever you choose!
Maths	This week learn the colour brown. Look at the different shades of brown you
	have found. My favourite shade of brown is the colour of milk chocolate.
	Recognise and read numbers 8, 9, 18, 19 and 20. Can you write them down or draw them with your finger? Find a circle, triangle, square and rectangle and talk about their properties. You could make sandwiches in different shapes!
Writing	This week make a party tea. Write a label for each plate of party food on the table. See if you can write the first letter and get an adult to help you with the rest of the word. You could make a place label for yourself and each member of your family.
Reading	Read 'The Three Billy Goats Gruff'. Say the repetitive parts of the story including 'Who's that trip trapping over my bridge'? Try to use different voices for each character. This week's sounds are q × ch sh  Use the letters we have learnt to make, spell aloud, write and read the words cat, mat, sat, frog, dog and log. Can you hear which of these words rhyme.  Ask an adult to sound out the letters below.  j-u-m-p, r-u-n, h-o-p j-o-g s-t-o-p f-r-o-g d-o-g  After listening to the sounds blend them together, say the word, and do the action for each word.
Wider Curriculum	Can you make Five Little Speckled Frogs and put them on a log? Look at pictures to help you with your design. Use your frogs to help you sing the rhyme. Find out about the life cycle of a frog. Take a picture or short video of your work and email
