Nursery Learning Challenges
I did kids Zumba on YouTube this week it was easy to follow and great fun!
Try doing Yoga Bugs this week. It's really fun and there are lots of different
themes to choose from. You will find it on YouTube.
Exercising daily really does make you feel happier and it's fun too!
This week learn the colours gold and silver. What objects can you find in your
house that are golds and silver? Recognise and read numbers 6, 7, 16 and 17. Can
you write them down or draw them with your finger? Find a rectangle and learn
that it has 2 short sides and 2 long sides and 4 corners.
This week ask an adult to help you plan a family picnic. Make everyone a name label
using alliteration for example Magic Mum, Fantastic Fin, Running Reece. Also make
a shopping list of the picnic foods you are having or make a menu for each guest.
Fingers crossed for nice weather.
Ask an adult to share your favourite stories with you.
This week's letter sounds are r j v y w z
Use the letters to make, spell aloud, write and read the words an, ran, van, fan, and
gran. Ask an adult to sound out the letters r-a-n, f-a-n, v-a-n, p-a-n.
After listening to the sounds blend them together and do an action for each word.
Can you make a picture or a model of 5 Little Ducks in a pond? You could visit a real
pond for ideas. Take a picture of your visit, model or picture and email it to me so I
can see what you have been up to! Don't forget to sing the 5 Little Ducks rhyme!
