Maths	Can you complete a number hunt (with numbers up to 20) around your house? Hide pieces of paper with a number written on it and when you find one, you have to do that many of a different type of exercise e.g. 5 star jumps, 12 hops, 9 jumps. Challenge someone else who lives in your house.
Reading	Please watch Ruth Miskin Set 2 sounds on YouTube at 10.00 every morning.
	Keep practising "ar – start the car" "or – shut the door?"
	Read Star part car fork short horse
	Find you favourite story book at home and get an adult to read it to you. Can you find any of our tricky red words that we have been learning in the story? Read them aloud and see if you can say the letters without looking at the word e.g. "the" say "t-h-e"
Writing	Apart from doing lots of school work, what else have you been doing during lockdown? Have you learnt something new? What have you enjoyed? What have you missed? Can you draw a picture and write a sentence about lockdown. Remember capital letters, full stops and finger spaces! How a go at writing your own sentence by yourself.
