Dear Parent/Carer,

Choir trip to perform at the Royal Festival Hall in London

We are now able to finalise the details for our choir trip to London and the performance at the Royal Festival Hall.

The children and staff will travel by coach to London on the morning of Sunday 10th June 2018. We hope to arrive in London by lunchtime and watch a theatre show that afternoon. We will spend Monday 11th June at the Royal Festival Hall on London's South Bank, rehearsing on the morning and performing between 2.00pm and 4.00pm. Afterwards, the children will picnic in Kensington Gardens and visit tourist sites in London, travelling back to their academies on Tuesday 12th June.

All children who are wanting to participate in this event will need to travel down and stay for the 2 nights. We have secured hotel rooms all together at the Premier Inn, near to the Embankment, for the children and staff. The children will be escorted and monitored by a member of staff in a group of up to five children.

The cost of the trip will be no more than £120 per child. Hopefully, this cost will be reduced if we can secure sponsorship over the next few months. We are also happy to set up a payment plan for weekly or monthly payments towards the final cost and this can be arranged by an appointment with Miss Lawton in the academy office.

A return coach journey for Monday 11th June has also been arranged for all parents/carers or family members wishing to attend the performance. It will leave early on Monday morning and return straight after the performance at approximately 4.20pm. It will then arrive back into Teesside around 11pm. The cost for each seat on the coach is £27.50 return. A non-refundable deposit of £5.00 per person/seat is required to secure a place.

In order to secure your child's place on this exciting trip/opportunity, please sign and return the reply slip below with a £10.00 non-refundable deposit. However, please be aware that being part of this trip does depend on children showing commitment to choir rehearsals and displaying excellent behaviour. If we have concerns about either of these circumstances, we will contact you. The academy reserves the right, under our Educational Visits policy, to withdraw the offer of a place on the trip to any child who is not behaving well or regularly attending choir rehearsals.
