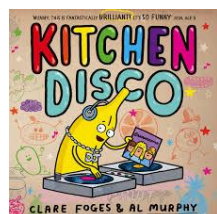

Maths	https://whiterosemaths.com/homelearning/year-1/ Summer Term – Week 2 Watch the video clip for each lesson and then complete the activity sheet. Parents – answers are also provided.
Reading	https://www.oxfordowl.co.uk/api/interactives/29266.html Open the story – No Way! Talk about the new vocabulary at the beginning of the text. Read the story then answer the questions on the final page. Once you have completed the questions, re-read the story to improve your fluency.
Writing	Keep a diary of your week. For each day, draw a picture and write sentences underneath to explain what you have been doing. Remember – capital letters, full stops and finger spaces.
Wider Curriculum	Look at paintings by Iris Scott. She uses her fingers to paint. Can you paint a picture in the style of Iris Scott? Use dots and marks made using your fingers. If you don't have any paint colour a picture using dots made from felt tips or coloured pencils.
