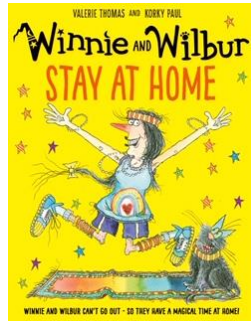

What day is it today? What day was yesterday? What day will it be tomorrow? Talk about when everyone in your house celebrates their birthday. Can you remember your birthday?</p>

Talk about the new vocabulary at the beginning of the text. Read the book then answer the questions on the final page. Once you have completed the questions, re-read the story to improve your fluency.</p>
<b>Writing</b>	<p>Let's play a little game - I know many of you like retelling or creating your own story. Pick your favourite traditional tale such as The Three Little Pigs. Retell the story in your own words. Remember to use your capital letters, finger spaces and full stops! <b>Don't write a title</b> and I will guess which traditional tale it is from your version of the story.</p>
<b>Wider Curriculum</b>	<p>ICT            Ask your adults at home to help you write an email to me. You need to type it and send it to me (adults – don't worry about their spelling). I will look forward to hearing how you are and what you have been up to.</p>
