

What day will it be tomorrow? Recap throughout the week. Months of the year - https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=Fe9bnYRzFvk Write the months of the year in the correct order. Talk about when everyone in your house celebrates their birthday. Can you remember your birthday?					
Reading	https://www.oxfordowl.co.uk/api/interactives/30463.html Open the story – At the seaside. Talk about the new vocabulary at the beginning of the text. Read the book then answer the questions on the final page. Once you have completed the questions, re-read the story to improve your fluency.					
Writing	Let's play a little game - I know many of you like retelling or creating your own story. Pick your favourite traditional tale such as The Three Little Pigs. Retell the story in your own words. Remember to use your capital letters, finger spaces and full stops! Don't write a title and I will guess which traditional tale it is from your version of the story.
