Who can find them first? m a s d t i n p g o c k u b f e l h Using the letters above, make a list of 'ed' words and a list of 'ig' words. Can you see the rhyming patterns? Which list is the longest?
Writing	Make a list of foods you are going to have for your picnic (see below). Write the initial letter of each food if you can. Make place cards for you and your family and write their names on them. Ask an adult for help if you need it. Have fun!
Wider Curriculum	With an adult make a delicious picnic to eat indoors or in the garden with your family. Please send a picture of your picnic to me so I can see what you have made.
