Subject	Nursery Learning Challenges
P.E.	Keep being active and exercising daily it really makes you feel happier and fitter and it is fun too! Get your family to take a photo of you exercising. I can't wait to find out what you have chosen to do. I had a water fight in the garden last week. It was so much fun!
Maths	Ask everyone in your family how old they are. Can you make their age with something you can find in your house? Hide numbers 1 to 5 around your house or garden. When you have found them all put them in sequence. Learn to say your own birthday and tell everyone in your house your birthday and your age. Write the numbers 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 twice on paper, leaves or stones. Play pairs by picking 2 numbers up at a time. Can you find two the same?
Writing	Write the beginning sounds for 6 of your toys or objects in your house. You could choose: teddy car doll map apple snake. Match the beginning letter to the toy or object. You will learn teddy begins with t car begins with c etc.
Reading	Say all of these letter sounds to an adult every day. m a s d t i n p g o c k u b f e l h r j v q u w x y z Keep practising as you will need to know them in Reception. Using the toys and beginning letters you made in the writing section, play I spy with my little eye. Say I spy with my little eye something beginning with the letter..... ? If the letter was 'c' your object would be 'car' if you used the list above. If you are confident you know the beginning sounds of most words have a go at I spy with objects you can see in one room of your house.
Wider Curriculum	Draw a picture of a flower or plant and get an adult to write the name of the plant on your picture. Can you name the parts of a plant including roots, flower and leaves? You could even make a daisy chain.
Academy Challenge	You may have seen Mr Long rap during our celebration assembly. Can you make up a rap or rhyme about our academy and all of the people and things that you miss? Send your performances to your teacher or our Facebook page and we will post them to the world!!
