#### Other activities:

How many of these activities can you complete before the end of the Autumn term?

#### Geography

- Using google maps; locate your house and street. Zoom out to look at the town. Zoom out again to look at the United Kingdom. Talk about where Redcar/ Dormanstown is located.
- 2) Children to learn their house number and street name.

#### Science
