During Autumn Term 1, our learning will be based on ourselves and our family. We will be learning about what we like and what makes us happy.

We will be exploring our senses and the environment through our story of 'We're Going on a Bear Hunt' and learning all about colours and days of the week through the story of 'The Very Hungry Caterpillar'.

To support our learning, we will also be reading and roleplaying some traditional tales including, 'Goldilocks and The Three Bears' and 'The Three Little Pigs'.

We are also going to be looking at what pets we have at home and how to look after them, this will provide lots of opportunities for the children to talk about and share their own experiences of pets.



Activity

How many of these activities can you complete before half term?

Story Telling- Tell the story; 'We're Going on a Bear Hunt', and be able to repeat the repetitive parts. For example; 'We're going on a bear hunt, we're going to catch a big one, what a beautiful day we're not scared.'

Art idea – Paint or draw a picture of a rainbow and learn the rainbow song. Can the children recognise and name the colours?

Geography idea – To go for a walk through the forest. Can they describe what they see? Can they find a twig, an acorn, a leaf, a tall tree?
