At Dormanstown Primary Academy computers and iPads are installed with internet access to help our learning. This agreement will keep us safe and help us to be fair to others.

Dormanstown Primary Academy will: -

- work at all times to maximise the safety of pupils in their use of the Internet
- provide an internet filtering system that restricts access to inappropriate materials
- supervise children's use of the Internet within the academy
- guide children in their safe and appropriate use of the Internet
- subscribe to educationally based sites and resources to help with a variety of curriculum areas



Pupil

- I will only access the systems and apps with my own login and password.
- If using a laptop, I will log off as soon as I have finished and return it to the correct place.
- If I am using an iPad, I will ensure it is returned to the docking station as soon as possible.
- I will not share my passwords with other children, and I will not use anyone else's passwords.
- I will only look at other people's files with their permission.
- I will only delete my own work.
- I will only e-mail people I know, or my teacher has approved, using my school email address.
- The messages I send, or material I upload or download, will be polite and responsible.
- I will report any unpleasant material or messages sent to me, to a member of academy staff. I will not respond to such messages.
- I will only take photos of people I have permission from.
- I will not deliberately browse, download, upload or forward material that could be considered offensive or illegal. If I accidentally come across any such material, I will report it immediately to my teacher.
- I will not give my home address, phone number, send a photograph or video, or give any other personal information that could be used to identify me, my family, my friends, or my academy.
- I will never arrange to meet someone who I have only ever had contact with on the Internet or by e-mail or in a chat room.
- I will ensure that my online activity, both in school and outside school, will not cause my academy, the staff, pupils or others distress or bring them into disrepute.
- I will respect the privacy and ownership of others' work at all times.
- I understand that all my use of the Internet and other related technologies in the academy can be monitored and logged and can be made available on request to teachers.
- I understand that these rules are designed to keep me safe and, if they are not followed, academy sanctions will be applied and my parent/carer will be contacted.
- If I bring any technology from home, such as a phone or tablet, I will hand it in to the office for safe keeping during the day and collect it before I leave school.

Parent/Carer

As a parent or carer, I give permission for my child to access the Internet. I understand that, whilst every endeavour is taken to ensure that suitable restrictions are in place, TVED or staff cannot accept responsibility in any way for the access by my child to unsuitable materials.

I agree to my child using Rockstars, Lexia, Showbie, Spelling Shed, Evidence for Learning and other programs/sites that The Academy deems suitable to support my child's learning.
