Early Years Speech, Language and communication Pathway



Conception - Birth

- Your Midwife will talk to you about how you can communicate with your bump.
- You will be told about Redcar and Cleveland's 'Start For Life' offer, the Family Hubs and Libraries at your booking appointment.
- Your Midwife may invite you to attend our Preparation for Parenthood course

0 - 2 years

- You will receive a 'New Birth Call' from the Family Hubs.
- Your Health Visitor will give you a Bookstart pack at your 6 to 8 week appointment.
- Visit our Family Hub groups, they can support your child's communication.
- At around 9 months your Health Visitor will check your child's progress.
- If your child goes to a nursery or a Childminder, they will monitor your child's speech and language skills.

2 - 4 years

- If your child goes to a nursery or a Childminder they will monitor your child's speech and language skills.
- At around 2 years old your Health Visitor will check your child's progress during a home visit.
- You can get advice from the Family Hub Speech and Language Therapist. To book a slot or for more information call: 01642 770810.
- Visit our Family Hub groups, they can support your child's communication.

Conception - Birth

- The Midwifery Indigo Team may offer extra support if you need it.
- You may be invited to attend our Preparation for Parenthood course.

0-2 years

- A Health Visitor may refer you to our Infant Massage group.
- Your Health Visitor can offer additional support for any speech, language or communication worries.
- A professional may refer your baby/child to Chat, Sing and Read.

2-3 years

- A professional may refer your child to Wriggle, Read and Rhyme. This is supported by the Family Hub's Speech and Language Therapist.
- Your child may be eligible for 15 hours free childcare, please check on the PIN website.
- You can get advice from the Family Hub Speech and Language Therapist. To book a slot or for more information call: 01642 770810.
- Your Health Visitor may assess and review your child in their nursery setting with your consent.

3-4 Years

- You can get advice from the Family Hub Speech and Language Therapist. To book a slot or for more information call: 01642 770810.
- At around 3 years old your Health Visitor may check your child's progress during a home visit.
- A professional may refer you and your child to our Early Words Together group.

0 - 2 years

- If your child has an identified need, a professional may refer you to Early Years Special Educational Needs and Disabilities support service.
- If your child has an identified need, a professional can refer you to the Specialist Speech and Language Service.

3 - 5 years

 Your child's education setting will have a SENDCO (Special Educational Needs and Disabilities Co-ordinator). You can discuss any worries about your child with them.
